Over time our Customers' have given us feedback on other uses that they have found for the product. Those uses and the suggested dilution rates are outlined below. Please Note: these are not Manufacturers claims, they are uses found, and fed back to us as successful, by our Customers.

**PURE OXYGEN ULTRA SHAMPOO DILUTION RATE**

Pure Oxygen ULTRA Shampoo is designed to be rinse free. When an animal is washed using the shampoo, do not rinse it off. It will help reduce the risk of skin conditions.

When used at stronger dilutions it will assist with a host of fungal and bacterial conditions and help the healing of small wounds. Ensure that the solution is sprayed onto the affected area right down to the skin, then leave to air dry.

Whether used on Humans or animals, if irritation or an adverse reaction occurs, rinse the affected area thoroughly with clean water. If symptoms persist, please consult your vet or doctor.

CONDITION	DILUTION
Animal Bathing	12.5 ml per litre of Water – do not rinse off
Animal Bedding	Wash with normal laundry powder plus half a cup of Pure Oxygen ULTRA Shampoo
Cat Urine	Spray undiluted onto flooring, for furniture dilute to 50 ml per litre of water and apply to affected area
Clothing Stains	Dilute to 100 ml per litre of water, spray on, allow to air dry.
Flea or Mosquito Bites (Humans or Animals)	Dilute to 50 ml per litre of water, spray on, allow to air dry.
Hot Spots	Dilute to 100 ml per litre of water, spray on, allow to air dry.
Mould Spots (Curtains)	Dilute to 100 ml per litre of water, spray on, allow to air dry then brush mould off.
Mudfever	50 ml per litre of water – increase to 100ml per litre of water for stubborn cases
Rain Scald	50 ml per litre of water – increase to 100ml per litre of water for stubborn cases
Ring Worm	50 ml per litre of water – increase to 100ml per litre of water for stubborn cases
Scratches / Small Wounds	Dilute to 100 ml per litre of water, spray on, allow to air dry.
Stubborn Stains – grass	Undiluted – leave for up to 10 minutes, then wash with the diluted solution above
Thrush – Horses hooves	50 ml per litre of water – increase to 100ml per litre of water for stubborn cases
